Interactive Sessions:

NCAA: Initial Eligibility Requirements and Recruiting Rules Overview

Presented by Monica Monk, Director of Compliance, Penn State University, this session will cover the NCAA initial eligibility requirements for immediate eligibility and participation in collegiate athletics at a Division I or II school. This will include the required core course distribution and progression and sliding scale requirements. An overview of Division I and II recruiting rules will also be covered including first permissible dates that college coaches may interact with prospective student-athletes and their family members.
